



UNITY PARK – First Street, Turners Falls.

Unity Park is the flagship facility of the Montague Parks & Recreation Department (MPRD), located in downtown Turners Falls, along the banks of the beautiful Connecticut River. MPRD has recently completed Phase II of a three phase project, with improvements that include a new playground, ball fields, basketball court, rain gardens, community garden, butterfly garden, sand volleyball court, and paved walking path with fitness stations. These improvements were funded by the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) through the Franklin County Rehabilitation & Housing Authority. However, improvements do not end there.
