Items not anticipated in the 48 hour posting period Guests: Peter & Jeanne Golrick Jeanne Golrick would like minutes from January 20, 2016 as well as from tonight's meeting (February 17, 2016) when available. Jeanne brought in paperwork stating MGL's regarding meeting minutes. Jeanne also brought in a copy of the Montague Recorder where her property and her name were mentioned as part of the monthly BOH Director's Report in January. Jeanne was upset that she was not notified that her property would be discussed at the monthly meeting and that she wants to have a record of the name(s) of who complained about her property. Gina responded that state law requires the BOH to respond to any complaint written, in person or on the phone whether it is anonymous and that minutes are available upon request. Gina also said that the BOH is not responsible for what the Montague Reporter prints; Jeanne will follow up with the paper. Jeanne Golrick said that she would be putting her records request in writing. Peter Golrick Chapter 30A Section 22 Subsection A – requires that a list of documents and exhibits be shown this is not happening with the BOS minutes. This also requires that the minutes can be released whether or not they have been approved with a watermark or notation that they are not approved.
