Mark Fairbrother called the meeting to order at 6:30 PM.

<u>Approval of Minutes:</u> <u>Motion</u> made by Deb Henson to approve the November 9, 2016 minutes as amended. Seconded by Donna Francis. <u>Motion passed</u>. Justin Fermann abstained

<u>Ratify a Request for Emergency Certificate EC#2016-01</u> filed by Integrated Wildlife Control on behalf of Eversource for removal of a new beaver dam behind 212 Montague City Road.

The Conservation Agent received an Emergency Certificate request dated November 16, 2016 from Integrated Wildlife Control on behalf of Eversource Energy. The request seeks to allow for the removal of a small beaver dam that was recently built downstream of an older beaver dam which is located behind 212 Montague City Road. The older dam has a pond leveler that was installed years ago and now flooding from the new dam has negated the effectiveness of the pond leveler. The pond is now flooding an Eversource electric transmission line access road. In addition, past high water levels here have caused problems for neighboring residential cellars especially during heavy rains.

Agent reported a site visit on 11/16/2016 and issued the preliminary EC on that day. The applicant submitted a complete package with photography and clearly listed dam breaching procedures. The Commission has been comfortable with these procedures in the past. The work was completed before the Commission Meeting
