Description

GreenLink will provide morning shuttle and connection services within Greenfield. GreenLink will provide fixed route bus service to Greenfield Community College, area employment centers, local schools, and will be timed for transfer connections at the JWO Transit Center. This route will become effective on September 5th, 2017.

Hours of Operation: Between 4:30 am and 11:00 am, Monday through Friday. No service on Saturday, Sunday, or FRTA holidays.

Route Frequency: Frequency will be varied, but no more than sixty (60) minutes between buses during service hours.


Some trips may be a few as thirty (30) minutes between departures.




Route 20 GreenLink Connector

Hours of Operation: Between 9:00 am and 9:00 pm, Monday through Friday. No service on Saturday, Sunday, or FRTA holidays.


Route Frequency: Continuous departures from the JWO Transit Center every sixty (60) minutes.




Route 21 Greenfield Community

Route 22 BlueLink Connector

Description

BlueLink will provide morning and evening shuttle services between Turners Falls and Millers Falls for connections with FRTA bus routes at Avenue A & 3rd St. Additionally, BlueLink will be timed to meet the needs of morning and evening commuters to/from Industrial Blvd for employment opportunities. This route will become effective on September 5th, 2017.

Hours of Operation: Between 6:00-9:00 am and 3:00-5:00 pm, Monday through Friday. No service on Saturday, Sunday, or FRTA holidays.

Route Frequency: Varied departures and routing patterns.




Route 22 BlueLink Connector


Route Map

Franklin Regional Transit Authority Summary of Fixed Route Service Changes—Effective September 5th, 2017

Route 23

Sunderland via Turners Falls, Millers Falls Center, and Montague Center

Description

This route will be tailored to provide commuter-style service between Greenfield, Turners Falls, Millers Falls Center, and Montague Center with connections to Pioneer Valley Transit Authority (PVTA) at Sugarloaf Estates towards UMass Amherst. The Route 23 will no longer travel along Deerfield St and Montague City Rd to Turners Falls. As of September 5th, Route 23 will travel via High St (French King Hwy) and over the Gill-Montague Bridge to Ave A & 3rd Street in Turners Falls.

The travel time between Ave A & 3rd St Turners Falls and UMass Amherst will be decreased to approx. forty-five (45) minutes. Both of these examples include time spent travelling with PVTA Route 31 between Sunderland and the UMass Graduate Research Center.

There will be four round trips daily. A fifth trip for mid-day service was proposed, but unfortunately this did not make it into the final service change plan.


Route 23 will better serve customers travelling from any of the above destinations to Greenfield Community College, with a direct connection between the Community College and the JWO Transit Center available the day. This route will become effective on September 5th, 2017.

Hours of Operation: Between 6:45 am and 8:00 pm, Monday through Friday. No service on Saturday, Sunday, or FRTA holidays.


Route Frequency: Four round trip departures from JWO Transit Center. Commuter-style route service with two (2) AM departures and two (2) PM departures.

Turners Falls – Greenfield Community College – Crosstown via Transit Center

Description


This route will travel from Ave A & 11th St in Turners Falls to Greenfield Community College via Food City, Stop & Shop Plaza, High St (French King Hwy), Franklin Medical Center, the JWO Transit Center, Main St, and Colrain Rd. Route 24 Crosstown will provide a new, direct, and convenient fixed route service between two major downtown business districts, multiple grocery stores, the hospital, multiple neighborhoods, major employment opportunities, and a community college. Additionally, Route 24 will be timed to meet all connections with other FRTA services at the JWO Transit Center throughout the day. This route will become effective on September 5th, 2017.

Hours of Operation: Between 9:15 am and 8:15 pm, Monday through Friday. No service on Saturday, Sunday, or FRTA holidays.

Route Frequency: Continuous departures from the JWO Transit Center every thirty (30) minutes. Semi-continuous departures from Greenfield Community College

and Ave A & 11th St approximately every sixty (60) minutes.



Route 24

Route 31 Northampton – Greenfield via Deerfield, Whately, Hatfield

Description

This route has been modified to travel south from the JWO Transit Center on Rtes. 5/10 to Elm St in South Deerfield. Depending on the time of day, Route 31 will service a combination of the South Deerfield village center, Frontier High School, and Pelican Products before travelling to the Whately Park and Ride via Sugarloaf St and Rte. 116.

After Whately Park and Ride, Route 31 will now travel either via I-91 or will continue along Rtes. 5/10 to Northampton. Route 31 trips using I-91 for a portion of travel have will be designated as "express" and will offer customers a decrease in travel time between Greenfield and Northampton. "Express" travel time has decreased to as few as thirty-five (35) minutes between end points. This route will become effective on September 5th, 2017.

Hours of Operation: Between 5:00 am and 7:00 pm, Monday through Friday. No service on Saturday, Sunday, or FRTA holidays.

Route Frequency: Continuous departures from the JWO Transit Center every two (2) hours.

Route 32 Orange – Greenfield via Turners Falls, Millers Falls, Erving

Description

This route will travel from the JWO Transit Center along Deerfield St and Montague City Rd to Ave A & 3rd St Turners Falls. From there it will travel to Millers Falls Center and Erving Center.

As a service expansion in Orange, during the AM trips, Route 32 will now service East River St, Colonial Acres Apartments, and Pinecrest Apartments before servicing Hannaford Supermarket, Walmart Supercenter, and Orange Center.


As a service expansion in Orange, during the PM trips, Route 32 will service Orange Center, Walmart Supercenter, and Hannaford Supermarket before providing service along East River St to the major apartment complexes while heading back towards Rte. 2 West. This route will become effective on September 5th, 2017.


Hours of Operation: Between 5:00 am and 7:00 pm, Monday through Friday. No service on Saturday, Sunday, or FRTA holidays.

Description

This commuter-style route will have minimal service changes. Route 41 will now selectively service Mohawk High School, Academy at Charlemont, and Charlemont Park and Ride for greatest route efficiency. Greenfield Community College will be serviced in both directions on the first AM trip departing the JWO Transit Center. This route will become effective on September 5th, 2017.

Hours of Operation: Between 7:00 am and 7:00 pm, Monday through Friday. No service on Saturday, Sunday, or FRTA holidays.


