E.G. also lets the group know that Gill is trying to have the name of the bridge corrected by the DOT by taking down the State plaque, which is incorrect. The MHC is in favor of this.

12:04pm: E.G MOTIONS to Adjourn. C.C. seconds. MOTION PASSES.
